Market Commentary:

This 4.14 ct Natural Blue Sapphire exhibits a classic medium-blue hue, complemented by loupe-clean clarity with minimal inclusions. The pear cut, while elegant and suitable for unique jewelry designs, is generally priced slightly below oval or round cuts due to lower mainstream demand. Its cut quality is rated as good, offering adequate brilliance though not optimal light return. Being heated, the sapphire aligns with accepted trade practices, though unheated stones typically command higher premiums. Sri Lanka origin adds credibility, as Ceylon sapphires are globally respected for their luster and quality. Demand for larger stones over 4 carats remains strong in international luxury markets, making this gem an attractive option for both collectors and high-end jewelers.
